Life With Hope and Belief: John Lonergan

John Lonergan worked in the Irish Prison Service for over 42 years, serving for over 22 years as Governor of Mountjoy Prison. Based on his long experience he believes that personal change cannot be enforced on people and that real and meaningful change can only be achieved from inside the person by focusing on the humanity and the potential in another human being. He argues that the more people are in touch with their own humanity, the more likely they are to respect their fellow human beings. He also believes that every person has the capacity to change and that every day is a new beginning and a new opportunity. He also strongly believes that there is no substitute for human kindness insisting that if human kindness doesn't work, nothing will. Finally he is convinced that a life without hope is no life at all.

John Lonergan is Former Governor of Mountjoy Prison, Dublin and Author of 'The Governor'. An inspirational speaker, he was keynote Speaker at the IACP AGM 2011.

When dealing with trauma and adversity, maintaining hope is a crucial human quality that ensures not only survival but also a transformation of the original traumatic experience.
